<i>Semesters</i>	<i>Courses Offered</i>	<i>Note</i>
<i>Fall of Junior Year</i>	EDS 201 and EDS 202	Students are advised to take both classes, during which the application package is completed.
<i>Spring of Junior Year</i>	EDS 317 EDS 201 or EDS 202	Students may take one of the foundation classes (EDS201/202) this semester if they were granted permission not to take it the previous term.
<i>Fall of Senior Year</i>	EDS 303	This follows EDS 317.
<i>Spring of Senior Year</i>	EDS 400 and EDS 401	They will take both: student teaching and seminar.

EDS 401 Reflection and Analysis in Student Teaching in Secondary Education	2 credits
